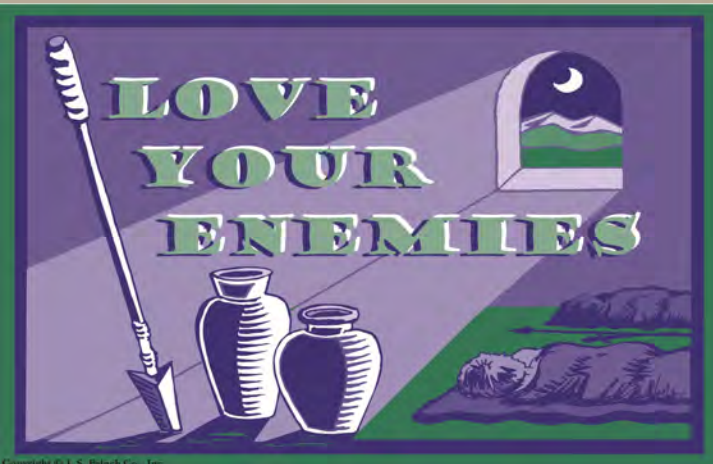

Synod 2021-2023

Pope Francis wants to hear from the whole Church about what is happening in local parishes. The way he has proposed doing this is a synodal process.

Synod means "journeying together" and it involves listening to the Holy Spirit and to each other in order to discern the path we are called to walk together. The synod "is intended to inspire people to dream about the Church we are called to be, to make people's hopes flourish, to stimulate trust, to bind up wounds, to weave new and deeper relationships, to learn from one another, to build bridges, to enlighten minds, warm hearts, and restore strength to our hands for our common mission."

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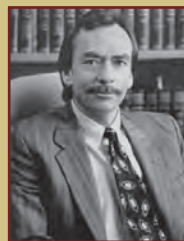
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
