

Happy Sunday!

This weekend we are back in Ordinary Time and our second reading comes from St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians. He writes in it, "Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? For you have been purchased at a price. Therefore glorify God in your body." In a world that is so focused on individual autonomy St. Paul's words resonate deeply. "You are not your own," he writes. Even more so, we have "been purchased at a price," this price is the Blood of Jesus. Human life is so precious because we are made to be temples of the Holy Spirit, and when we were lost in sin, Christ redeemed us by His Passion.

As we reflect on St. Paul's words and the great gift of human life, I wish to call your attention to something very important coming up in Flagstaff. On February 14th, Ash Wednesday, 40 Days for Life will begin. 40 Days for Life is a prayer campaign to pray for the unborn and an end to abortion. In our parish we are glad to have a devoted group of people organizing these efforts in this most important work. They will be inviting people to sign up for an hour of prayer for the unborn and an end to abortion throughout the season of Lent. We would love to be able to stand up for life and fill as many hours as possible during these 40 days. This can be a great Lenten practice for individuals or to do as a family. Please prayerfully consider supporting this important ministry. Their kickoff will be Saturday February 10th. Further details will follow.

Este fin de semana volvemos al Tiempo Ordinario y nuestra segunda lectura proviene de la Primera Carta de San Pablo a los Corintios. Él escribe: "¿O es que no saben ustedes que su cuerpo es templo del Espíritu Santo, que han recibido de Dios y habita en ustedes? No son ustedes sus propios dueños, porque Dios los ha comprado a un precio muy caro. Glorifiquen, pues, a Dios con el cuerpo." En un mundo tan centrado en la autonomía individual, las palabras de San Pablo resuenan profundamente. "No eres tuyo", escribe. Más aún, hemos sido "comprados por un precio", este precio es la Sangre de Jesús. La vida humana es tan preciosa porque estamos hechos para ser templos del Espíritu Santo, y cuando estábamos perdidos en el pecado, Cristo nos redimió por Su Pasión.

Mientras reflexionamos sobre las palabras de San Pablo y el gran don de la vida humana, deseo llamar su atención sobre algo muy importante que se avecina en Flagstaff. El 14 de febrero, Miércoles de Ceniza, comenzarán 40 Días por la Vida. 40 Días por la Vida es una campaña de oración para orar por los no nacidos y el fin del aborto. En nuestra parroquia nos alegra tener un grupo devoto de personas organizando estos esfuerzos en esta obra tan importante. Invitarán a la gente a inscribirse para una hora de oración por los no nacidos y el fin del aborto durante la temporada de Cuaresma. 




