



For those of you who do not know me yet, I am Fr. Carlos Gomez Rivera, your Parochial Vicar here at San Francisco de Asís Parish. I have been with you nearly two months. Please allow me to tell you a little bit about my life.

I was born in Sonora Mexico. My parents are still alive and live in Sonora, Mexico. They have been sacramentally married for 57 years! I am the second of four boys. All of us finished Medical School and received a degree in General Surgery. My two youngest brothers both specialized, one in Orthopedics and the other in Neurosurgery. My oldest brother is also a priest and is serving the Mission of Our Lady of Fatima in downtown Phoenix.

God then had other plans for me! I attended Seminary formation at Saint Meinrad Seminary and School of Theology (Benedictine Monastery) in Southern Indiana. I have been an ordained an Catholic Priest for nearly 21 years. I have served in the Diocese of Phoenix at St. Timothy Church in Mesa, St. Mary's in Chandler, and as the pastor of Saint Augustine's in west Phoenix for 17 years.

After completing my term as pastor, I then took a three-month Sabbatical at the North American College in Rome. Now, I am here to serve you. I hope these words give you a better understanding of my personal life and pastoral background. Please keep me in your prayers, just as I am doing the same for you.

Los dos hermanos menores se casaron y viven con sus familias en Sonora. Ellos hicieron otras especialidades médicas; uno en Ortopedia y el otro en Neurocirugía.

Llevé mi formación sacerdotal en el seminario de Saint Meinrad School of Theology (Monasterio Benedictino) en Indiana. Ya llevo ordeñado Sacerdote Católico cerca de 21 años.
