

This weekend we welcomed Bishop Nevares to confer Confirmation and give First Communion to nearly 100 of our children and adult candidates! Thank you for keeping them all in your prayers! A special thanks to our staff and their teams for preparing everyone for their Sacraments. What a beautiful day!

You might have noticed in the bulletin a few weeks ago an advertisement for a mother's prayer group called Mothers of Lu. Lu of Monferrato is a town in Italy where a group of mother's from the town gathered together regularly to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life from their own children. From the town of Lu came 323 vocations, 152 priests and 171 women religious! We will be beginning our own group for mothers, grandmothers, godmothers, etc. to gather together and pray a holy hour every month for vocations from our own families. 



Declaration of the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith

"Dignitas Infinita" on Human Dignity

April 8, 2024



This past week the Vatican's Dicastery for the Doctime of the Faith published a Declaration on Human Dignity (Dignitas Infinita). Each human person has infinite dignity, because they are created in the image and likeness of God. Below is the link and the first paragraph of the Introduction.

> Topics summarized in this document include: Biblical Perspectives, Poverty, War, Migrants, Sexual Abuse, Violence Against Women, Abortion, Euthanasia and Assisted Suicide, Marginalization of People with Disabilities, Gender Theory, Sex Change, Digital Violence, and more.

1. (Dignitas Infinita) Every human person possesses an infinite dignity, inalienably grounded in his or her very being, which prevails in and beyond every circumstance, state, or situation the person may ever encounter. This principle, which is fully recognizable even by reason alone, underlies the primacy of the human person and the protection of human rights. In the light of Revelation, the Church resolutely reiterates and confirms the ontological dignity of the human person, created in the image and likeness of God and redeemed in Jesus Christ. From this truth, the Church draws the reasons for her commitment to the weak and those less endowed with power, always insisting on "the primacy of the human person and the defense of his or her dignity beyond every circumstance." https://press.vatican.va/content/salastampa/en/bollettino/ pubblico/2024/04/08/240408c.html
