

Excerpts from the Lectionary for Mass @2001, 1998, 1970 CCD.

Happy Sunday!

This Tuesday, August 6th, we begin the parish wide consecration to Jesus through Mary. I have received some logistical questions about how this takes place. As you know I recommended a couple of different books to help you along the way. You may have found other consecration books that are suitable and that could also be a great option. The daily prayers for the consecration can be done in private, with friends, or with family. In this way the 33 day consecration is rather informal. On September 8th, Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary Chapel will be open from 9 am until 3 pm so that you may do the final day of consecration prayers in Our Lady's Chapel on the feast day. If you miss a day throughout the consecration just keep going. The overall intention of the 33 day consecration is to deepen our life of prayer and draw closer to Jesus through His mother. I pray that this is a fruitful time of prayer and growth in the spiritual life for each of you! As always, know of my prayers!

La intención general de la consagración de 33 días es profundizar nuestra vida de oración y acercarnos a Jesús a través de Su madre. ¡Rezo para que este sea un tiempo fructífero de oración y crecimiento en la vida espiritual para cada uno de ustedes! ¡Como siempre, sepan que están en mis oraciones!



YOUTH MINISTRY SUMMER RETREATS UPDATE

Thank you all so much for your generosity with the Envelop Mission fundraiser! We were able to give scholarships and take down the cost of our summer retreats so that the teens could go without worrying about the cost and God definitely worked in some beautiful ways throughout this summer.

For our Verso L'alto Summer Camp, we talked about Mary and how she brings us closer to God. Two things stood out to me from this retreat. First, one of our high schoolers helped lead this middle school retreat by leading a small group and giving a talk. It was so amazing to hear her testimony and talk on Mary and seeing how the youth responded to her experience. Second, at the en d of the retreat we prayed a rosary and gave roses to Mary. The youth got to take a rose along with whatever it was they wanted to offer up or entrust to Mary and place it in the vase and say a little prayer. Afterwards, one of the middle schoolers told me how powerful it was to do that and invite Mary to help him grow closer to Jesus.

For our Quo Vadis high school retreat at the Steubenville West Conference, the theme was Illuminate. We had amazing times of prayer, discussion, and lots of fun. One teen expressed how excited she was to bring what she had learned on this retreat to the rest of her life. Before this weekend she felt that her faith was just there, something she's always done, but now she feels more connected to God and wants to continue to explore that relationship.


