Happy Sunday!

This week on Thursday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary into Heaven. We will have four Masses for this Holy Day of Obligation. There will be a 5:30 pm Vigil Mass at Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary Chapel on Wednesday night, the 14th. On the 15th there will be a 6:30 am Mass at Our Lady of Guadalupe, 8:15 am and 12:15 pm Mass at SFdA. In a nice little book on the Blessed Mother by Cardinal Ratzinger, called "Daughter Zion," he tells us, "that when the Church affirms Mary's Assumption into Heaven, body and soul, it is the highest form of canonization." That is, it is the most complete way we can affirm someone is in heaven. Because Mary did not sin and did not experience original sin, she did not suffer the same effects of sin, namely bodily death. What does this look like? We don't know exactly. Sacred art over the centuries has attempted to shed light on this mystery in numerous ways. One image in our Nativity chapel shows the disciples gathered around the casket of Mary with her rising above. The casket itself is filled with flowers. The flowers remind us of the beauty of life and the beauty of the Blessed Mother. Their vibrancy also tells us that the casket is for Mary not a place of death. As we celebrate the Assumption we are especially aware that God desires to raise our mortal bodies to eternal life. What better way to enter into that reality than to fulfill our obligation on this great solemnity to attend Mass and receive the Bread of Eternal Life.

El jueves de esta semana celebramos la Solemnidad de la Asunción de María al Cielo. Tendremos cuatro Misas para este Día Santo de Precepto. Habrá una Misa de Vigilia en la Natividad el miércoles 14 a las 5:30 pm. El jueves 15 habrá Misa a las 6:30 am en Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe, a las 8:15 am y a las 12:15 pm Misa en San Francisco de Asís. En un simpático librito del Cardenal Ratzinger sobre la Santísima Madre, llamado Hija Sión, nos dice que cuando la Iglesia afirma la Asunción de María al Cielo, en cuerpo y alma, es la forma más elevada de canonización. Es decir, es la forma más completa en la que podemos afirmar que alguien está en el cielo. Como María no pecó ni experimentó el pecado original, no sufrió los mismos efectos del pecado, es decir, la muerte corporal. ¿A qué se parece esto? No lo sabemos exactamente. A lo largo de los siglos, el arte sacro ha intentado iluminarnos sobre este misterio de numerosas maneras. Una imagen en nuestra capilla de la Natividad muestra a los discípulos reunidos alrededor del ataúd de María con ella elevándose hacia lo alto. El ataúd en sí está lleno de flores. Las flores nos recuerdan la belleza de la vida y la belleza de la Santísima Madre. Su vivacidad también nos dice que el ataúd no es un lugar de muerte para María. Al celebrar la Asunción, somos especialmente conscientes de que Dios desea resucitar nuestros cuerpos mortales a la vida eterna. ¿Qué mejor manera de entrar en esa realidad que cumplir con nuestra obligación en esta gran solemnidad de asistir a la Misa y recibir el Pan de Vida Eterna?

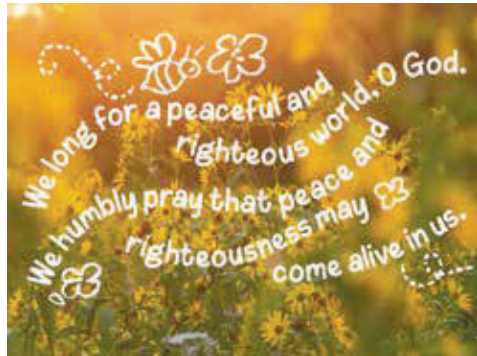

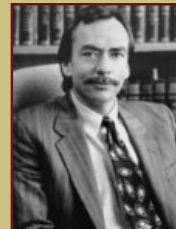

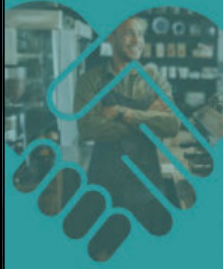
