



Kairos Outside offers a non-judgmental retreat for women to support each other as they journey through life affected by incarceration-that of a relative, friend or loved one, or their own past incarceration. The Kairos Outside weekend is a 2 1/2 day program based on a series of talks by volunteers, designed to address the pain of enduring separation from the one inside and the judgment of others in their community. Guests hear and discuss the talks in small table family groups. The program is interspersed with music, prayer, and fun activities. There is no cost to our Guests to attend the weekend. Any woman 20 years or older who has a relative, friend or loved one who is or has been incarcerated, or who has been incarcerated herself but was not able to attend a Kairos Inside weekend, may attend a Kairos Outside weekend. The weekend has a Christian focus and is hosted by volunteers of many different Christian denominations, but Guests do not have to be Christians to attend. 


