



Happy Divine Mercy Sunday!

Today the Church exults in the great mercy of God. A few years ago I gave a homily about a man who had committed numerous war crimes and yet, when he was in prison waiting to die, he asked for a priest. It was very difficult to find a priest but after a few days a priest was brought to him to hear his confession and bring him Holy Communion before he died. The Monday after the homily I received a very long voicemail rebuking me for using this person as an example. I was told I shouldn't use such a public sinner as to make a point. It makes me think now of a quote from St. Faustina's diary, "The greater the sinner, the greater the right he has to My mercy." God is wasteful in the best sense of the word! He is indeed the sower who liberally sows seed wherever the eye can see. And he sows his mercy for us! Each of us sins, and each of us is made for God's mercy. I pray that during this Easter season each of us may be touched by God's boundless mercy! Know of my prayers!

Fue muy difícil encontrar uno, pero después de unos días le trajeron uno para que lo confesara y le diera la Sagrada Comunión antes de morir. El lunes después de la homilía recibí un correo de voz muy largo reprendiéndome por usar a esta persona como ejemplo. Me dijeron que no debería utilizar a un pecador tan público para dejar claro este punto. Esto me recuerda una cita del diario de Santa Faustina: «Cuanto más pecador es, mayor derecho tiene a Mi misericordia». ¡Dios es un derrochador en el mejor sentido de la palabra! Él es, en verdad, el sembrador que siembra liberalmente dondequiera que el ojo pueda ver. ¡Y él siembra su misericordia para nosotros! Cada uno de nosotros peca, y cada uno de nosotros está hecho para la misericordia de Dios. ¡Rezo para que durante esta temporada de Pascua cada uno de nosotros podamos ser tocados por la misericordia ilimitada de Dios!




